<b>Program Design</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Separate Personal Leave and Holiday program</li> <li>• Employer-paid short-term disability</li> </ul>
<b>Vacation/Personal Leave (PL)</b>	
<b>Number of Days</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 18-28 days for full time employees based on years of service, not including 11 legal holidays (part time employee accrual prorated)</li> <li>• Front-loaded allotment</li> <li>• No waiting period</li> </ul>
<b>Carryover</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No carryover</li> </ul>
<b>Annual Cash Out</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No annual cash out</li> </ul>
<b>Separation Payout</b>	Pro-rated payout (based on number of complete pay periods) upon separation from JHS, up to 80 hours (less than 10 years of service) and up to 120 hours (10 or more years of service)
<b>Holidays</b>	
<b>Number of Days</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 11 Legal Holidays Recognized</li> <li>• Not eligible for payout upon separation/No annual cash-out or carryover after September</li> </ul>
<b>Short-term Disability</b>	
<b>Short-Term Disability (STD)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Automatic, employer-paid benefit (current voluntary short-term disability premiums will be discontinued resulting in bi-weekly savings to employee)</li> <li>• Benefit equals 60% of weekly pay up to a maximum of \$1,000 with a buy up option.</li> <li>• Eligible to receive Short Term Disability benefit payments following 6 working days</li> </ul>
